

Kempston Camera Club is aimed at amateur photographers. It runs a 'studio group' to allow members interested in studio/model photography to learn about this type of photography and practice making images within this particular area of interest.

The model is booked for these evenings by the club on the basis that the images are primarily intended for the private use of the photographer and possible inclusion within competitions. It is clearly understood that many models will not object to the images being used for commercial purposes but it is necessary to protect the rights of those that have only agreed to model on the basis of private use only.

To ensure that images are not used for any commercial purposes contrary to the arrangements made with the model at the time of booking, model release forms will be available on studio group meeting evenings. If any member intends or wishes to use any image taken at a studio group meeting for any commercial purpose the member must ensure that they obtain a signature from the model on the model release form.

Commercial use will include the sale' on either a physical media or electronically through a website, and the use of the image for advertising purposes on any format.

Commercial use without a signed model release form will be considered a breach of Kempston Camera Club rules.

Obviously none of this would prevent a member from booking the model for a separate private photographic session and most models will provide a business card containing details that will facilitate this.
